

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## SALE AND SUPPLY OF ALCOHOL ACT 2012

### Section 101

**Sherwood Estate Wines Limited** has made application to the District Licensing Committee at Amberley for the **Renewal** of the **Off-Licence** in respect of the premises situated at 113P Church Road, Glenmark, Hurunui district known as **Sherwood Estate Wines Limited**.

The general nature of the business conducted under the licence is that of a **Winery**.

The days on which and the hours during which alcohol is sold under the licence are:

**Monday to Sunday from 9.00am to 5.00pm**

The application may be inspected during ordinary office hours at the office of the Hurunui District Licensing Committee at 66 Carters Road, Amberley.

Any person who is entitled to object and who wishes to object to the grant of the application may, not later than 15 working days after the date of the first publication of this notice, file a notice in writing of the objection with the Secretary of the Hurunui District Licensing Committee, P O Box 13, AMBERLEY.

No objection to the renewal of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

The objection period for this application closes on 24 May 2021.

## Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), Sherwood Estate Wines Limited (the Licensee) is authorised to sell on or from the premises situated at 113P Church Road, Glenmark, *and known as Sherwood Estate Wines Limited*", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

### CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made—
  - (i) on the premises; or
  - (ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated:
- (c) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Monday – Sunday from 9.00am to 5.00pm.**
- (d) Drinking water must be freely available from the bar to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, the licence expires on:

6th day of May 2021
